Emmanuel N. He served as Managing Director/Chief Executive Officer of UBA Africa, overseeing the Group's subsidiaries in 18 African countries and directing the execution of its regional expansion strategy. Earlier in his UBA career, he held the positions of Group Chief Operating Officer and Group Chief Financial Officer, with responsibility for Finance and Risk, as well as Executive Director roles in Finance, Risk, and the Group Executive Office. He most recently served as a Non-Executive Director on UBA's Board, bringing continuity and deep institutional insight to his current mandate.

Mr. Nnorom is a chartered accountant by profession. He brings over four decades of distinguished experience in banking, finance, audit, operations and corporate governance. He is an alumnus of Templeton College, Oxford, where he completed executive leadership and management programmes, and a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria (ICAN), as well as an Honorary Member of the Chartered Institute of Bankers of Nigeria (CIBN).
